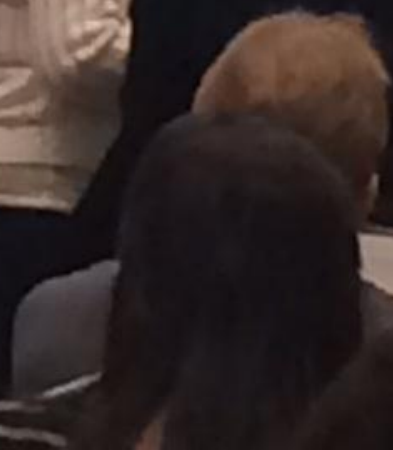
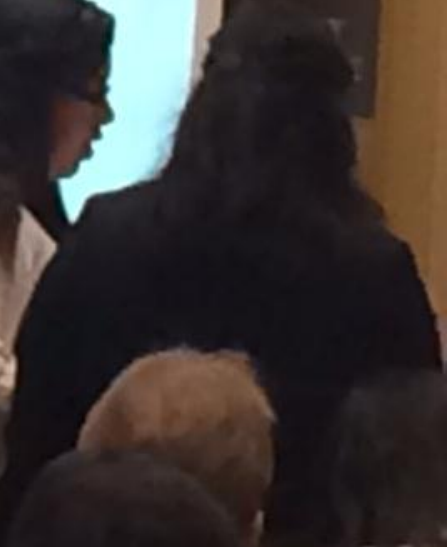


Some Conference Workshops

- ❑ Walking the Talk--Implementing the Common Core Standards into Teacher Preparation Courses; strategies for implementing Common Core standards into existing curriculum**

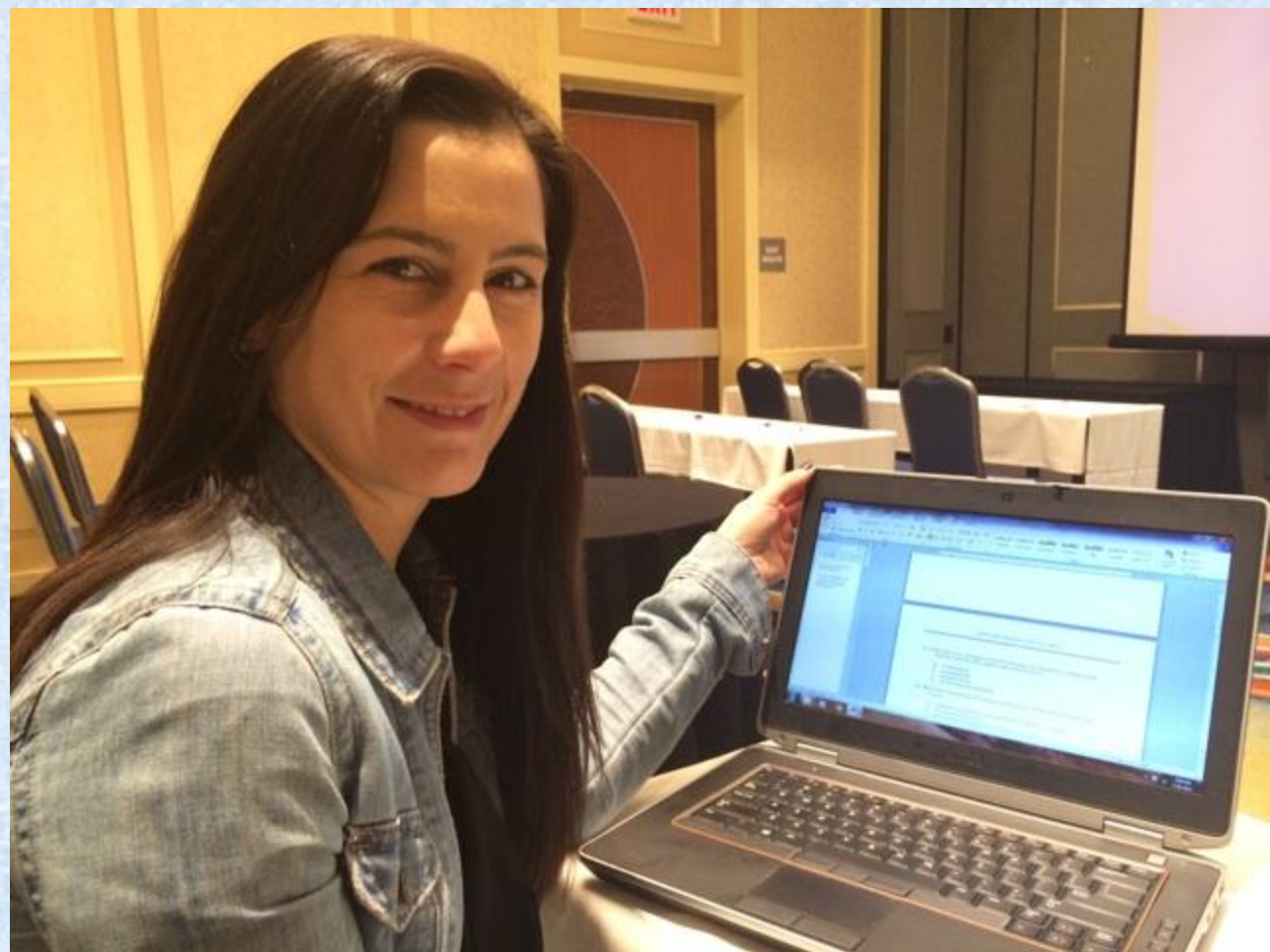
